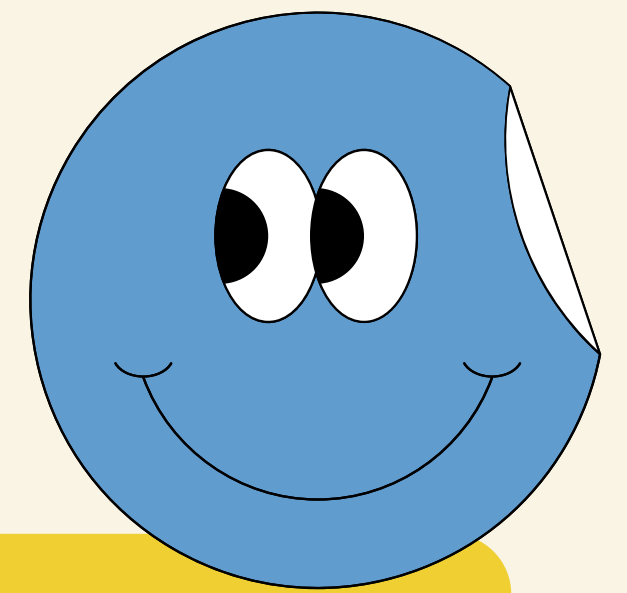


IDENTIFYING A LANGUAGE FUNCTION



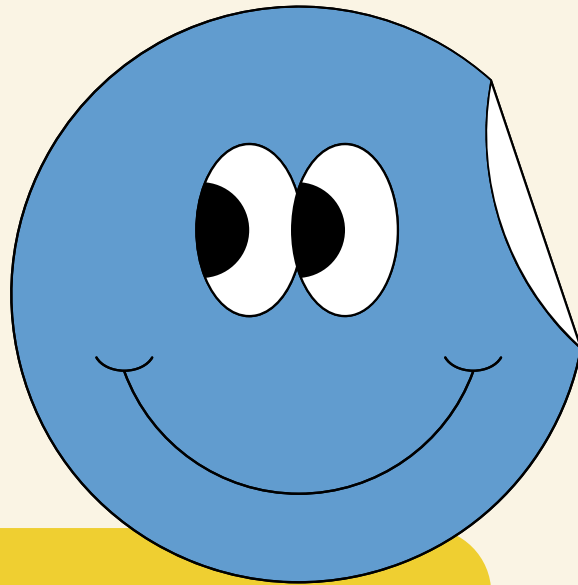

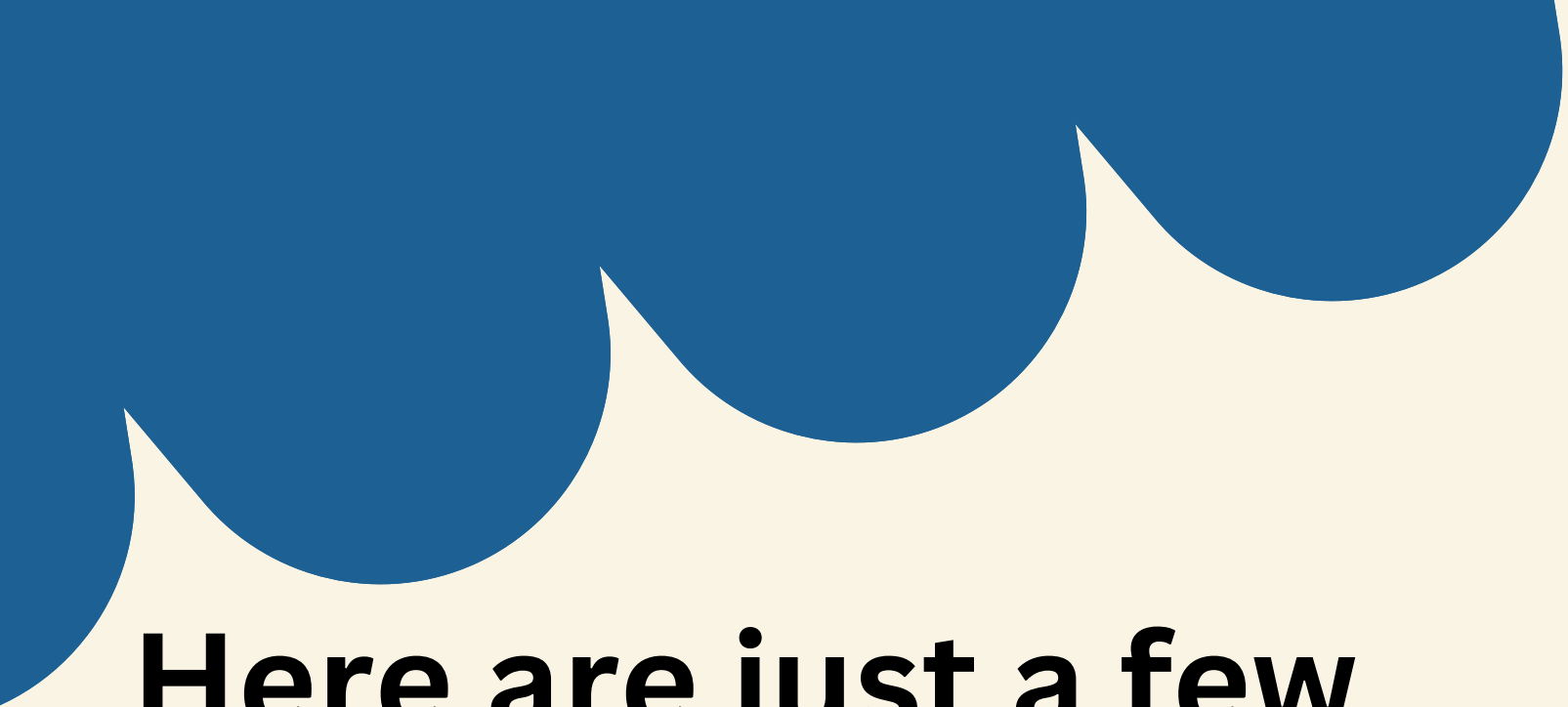
Identifying language functions is important because it helps us to understand the meaning and context of a message, allows us to respond appropriately, and helps us to avoid misunderstandings. For students, it helps them determine what to look for and how to answer a question.



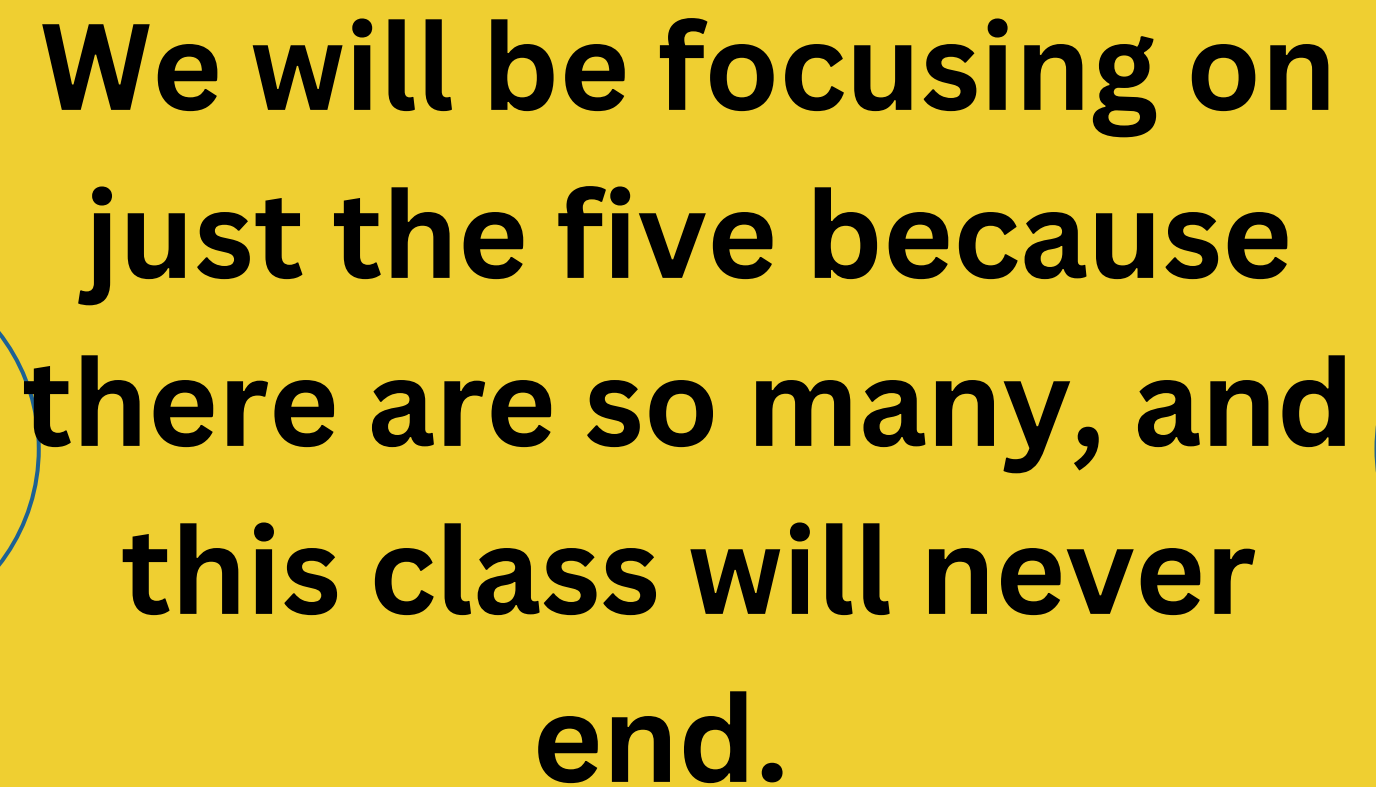

Here are just a few others: inform, seek information, order, classify, analyze, infer (very difficult for language learners), and evaluate.

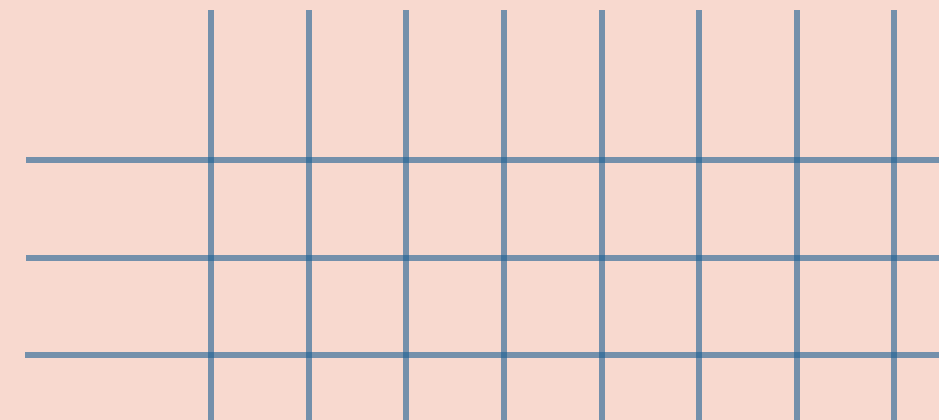
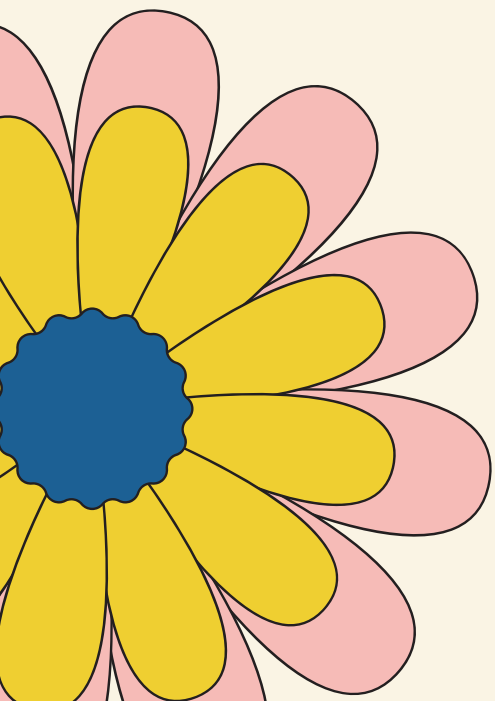

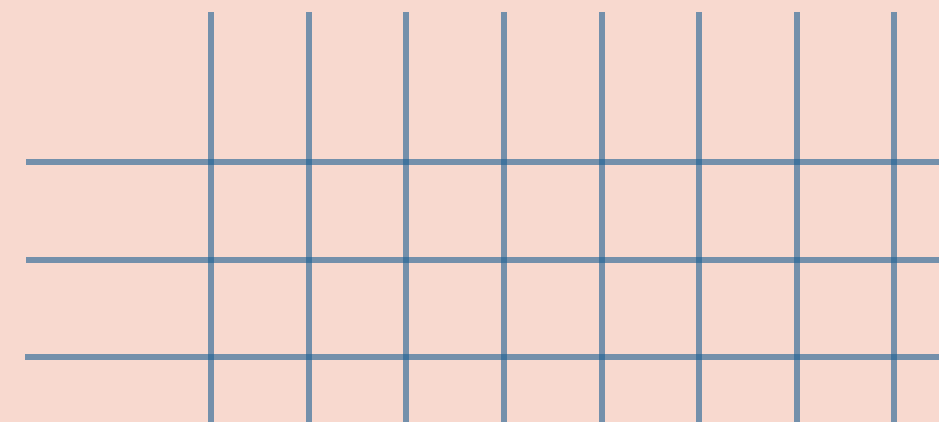
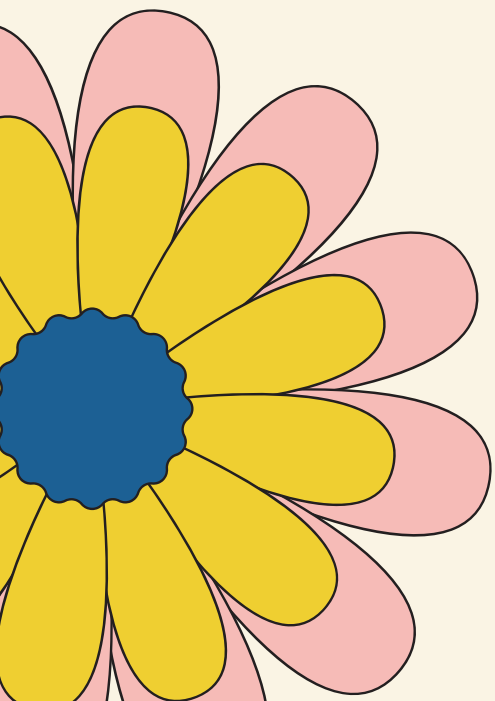
WHAT ARE FUNCTIONS

Functions are what we do with the language. For the students, it is the purpose of the language. For example, they may write out a sequence of events for history, argue and support their math answers, or compare two different scientific hypotheses.

Functions play an important role in developing students' language proficiency in all content areas as they help students communicate effectively in a variety of situations.



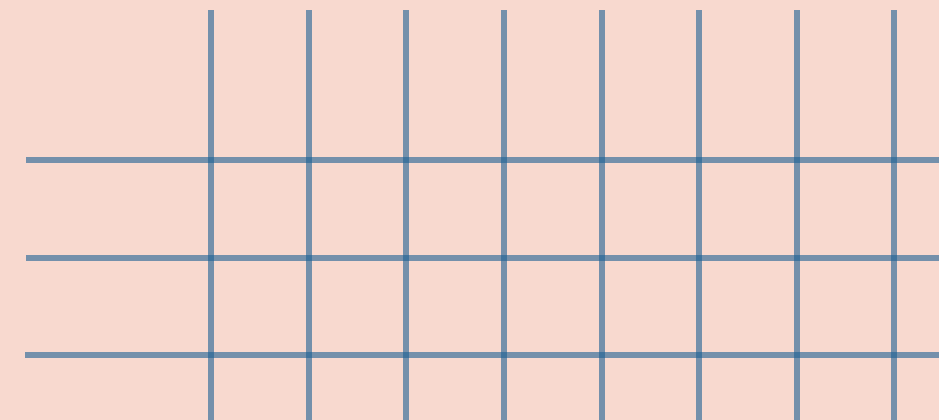
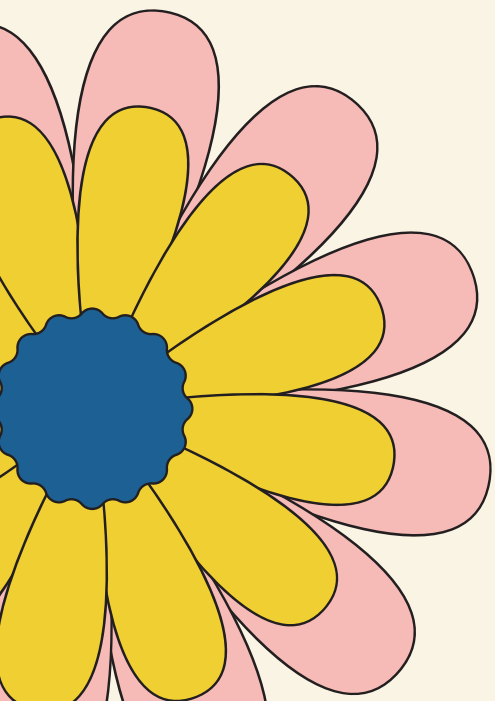
THE ROLE FUNCTIONS PLAY

THE ROLE FUNCTIONS PLAY

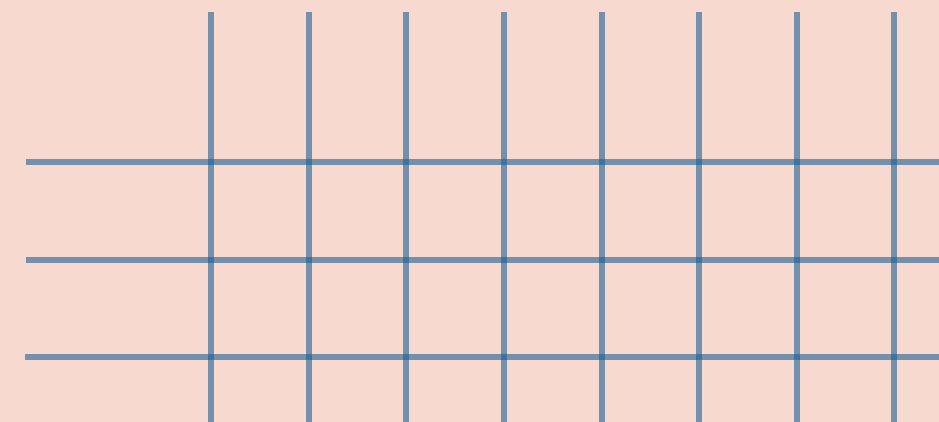
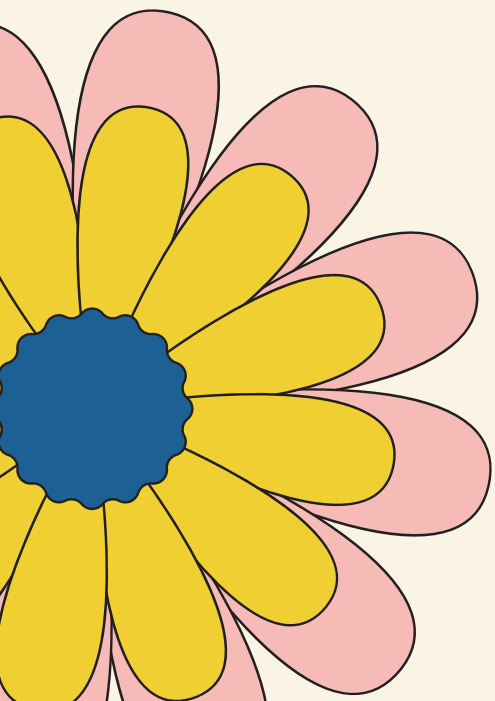
Language functions aid students in developing higher-order thinking skills enabling them to think critically, logically, and creatively.

Knowledge of the function allows students to use the language more complexly.



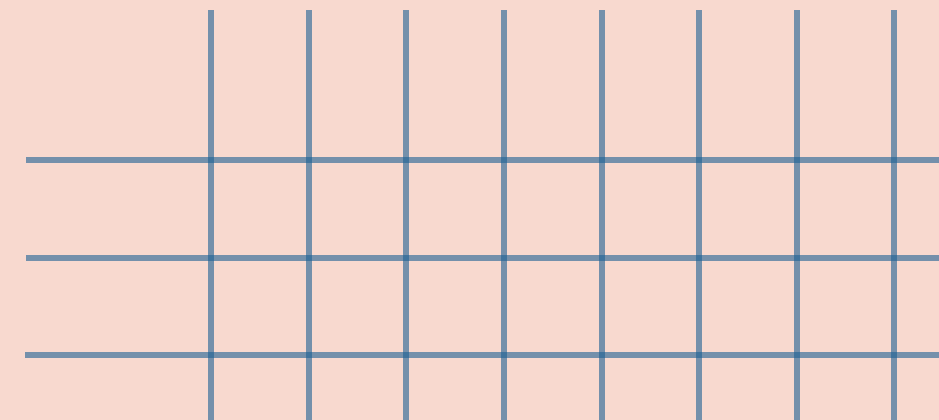
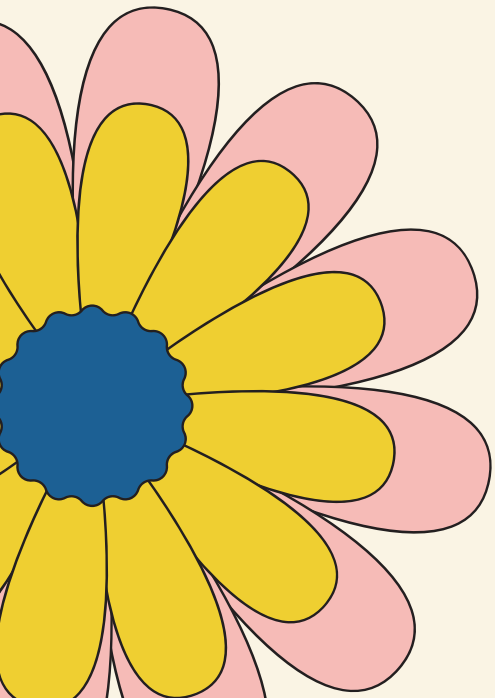
THE ROLE FUNCTIONS PLAY

Language functions introduce students to new vocabulary words and help them learn how to use them in context.



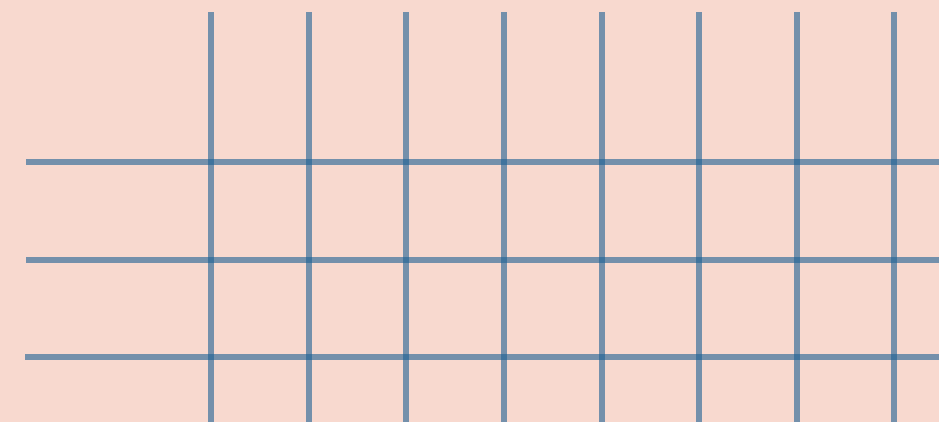
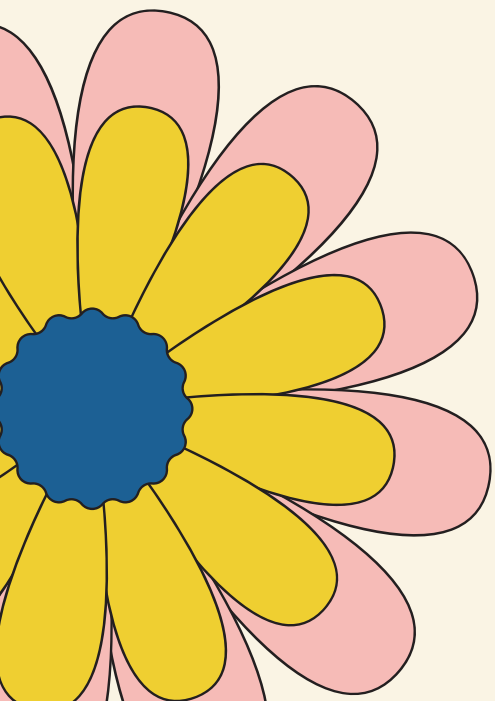
THE ROLE FUNCTIONS PLAY

Using language functions in their writing and speaking, students learn to organize their thoughts, present their ideas clearly, and support their arguments with evidence.



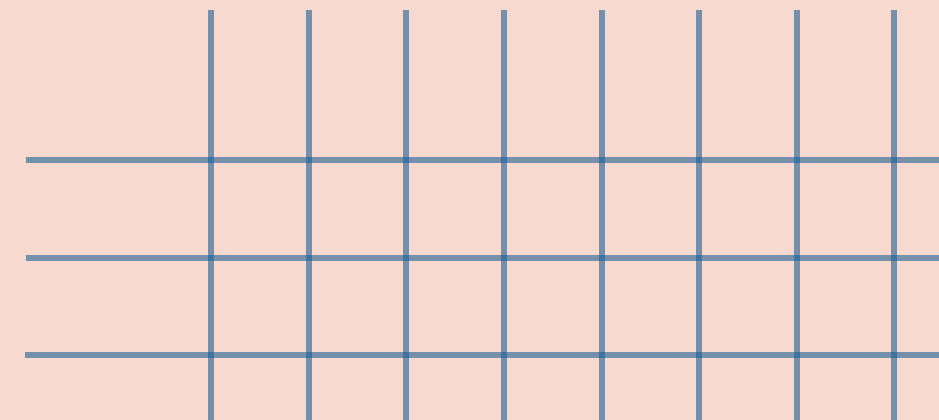
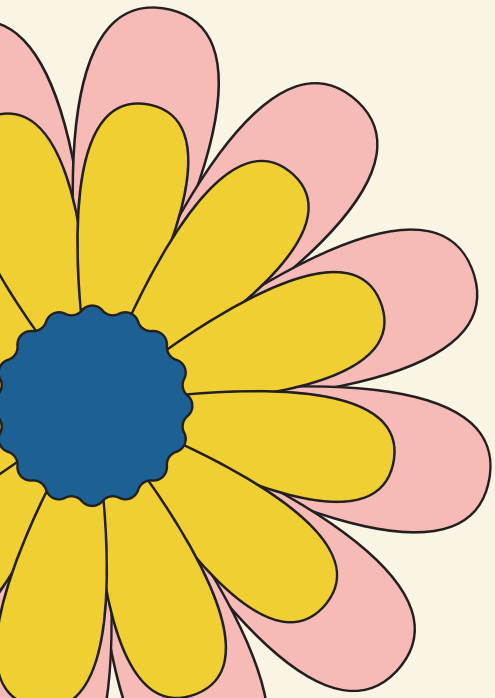
THE ROLE FUNCTIONS PLAY

Language functions are crucial for academic achievement as they help students to understand and analyze texts, participate in discussions, and write essays and research papers.

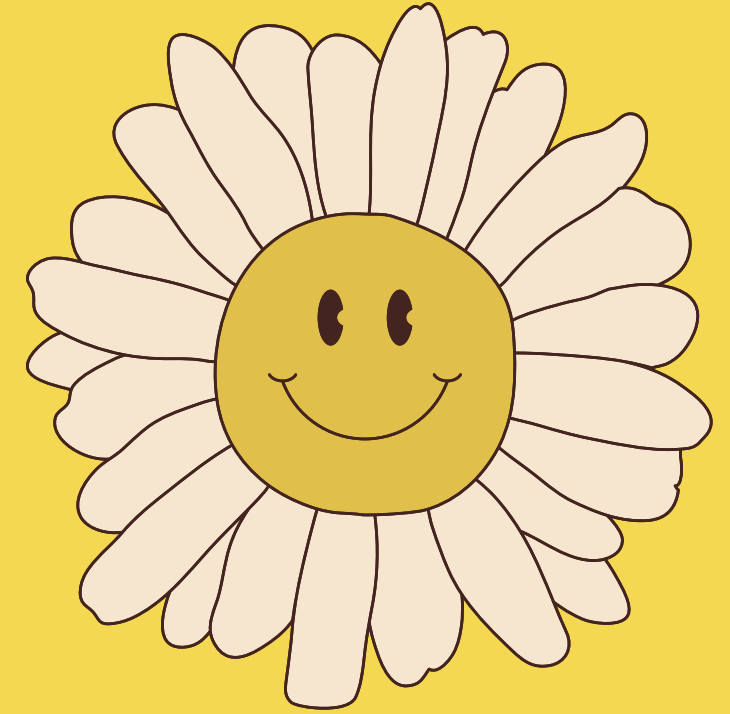

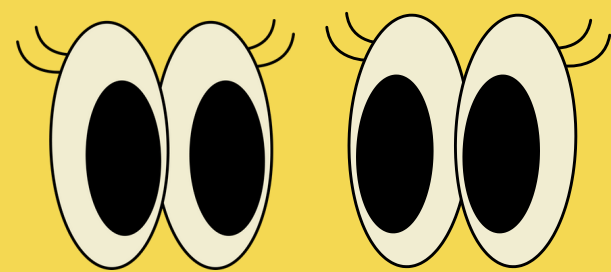
