For the purposes of this course, we will focus on five language functions.

Here are just a few others: inform, seek information, order, classify, analyze, infer (very difficult for language learners), and evaluate.

We will be focusing on just the five because there are so many, and this class will never end.

WHAT ARE FUNCTIONS

Functions are what we do with the language. For the students, it is the purpose of the language. For example, they may write out a sequence of events for history, argue and support their math answers, or compare two different scientific hypotheses.


Functions play an important role in developing students' language proficiency in all content areas as they help students communicate effectively in a variety of situations.

Functions promote active use of language by encouraging students to use language thoughtfully to express their ideas, opinions, and thoughts. Using functions, students can convey their meaning and communicate their message effectively aiding in the learning of the content.

Language functions aid students in developing higher-order thinking skills enabling them to think critically, logically, and creatively. Knowledge of the function allows students to use the language more complexly.

Language functions introduce students to new vocabulary words and help them learn how to use them in context.






Using language functions in their writing and speaking, students learn to organize their thoughts, present their ideas clearly, and support their arguments with evidence.


Language functions are crucial for academic achievement as they help students to understand and analyze texts, participate in discussions, and write essays and research papers.
